

Harvesting Traditions! September 7, 2024 Parade Registration Form

FOR THE SAFETY OF ALL ENTRANTS AND SPECTATORS PLEASE OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING RULES OF CONDUCT:

- 1. Speed limit of 5 mph on the parade route and near pedestrians.
- 2. No Burnouts.
- 3. Use caution and toss candy far away from the vehicle.

4. No parking or unloading on the parade route. Passengers may only be unloaded once reaching the

unload zone as indicated on the parade route map and signage on the day of the event.

5. Stay in line throughout the parade.

6. Check-in closes at 9:30 AM - no exceptions. Failure to check in by 9:30 AM will result in not being able to join the parade.

Failure to follow any of the above conditions may result in not being able to participate in the parade in future events

LINEUP STARTS AT 8 AM:

- \bullet Enter the parade lineup off of $7^{\rm th}\,and\,SH\,79$
- Proceed to $7^{{\tt TH}} {\tt ST.}$ AND LINCOLN AVE to check in.
- **REMAIN IN LINE**. At 9:30 am parade attendant will walk parade line-up and finalize judging roster.
- All parade participants must follow the route as indicated. You may drop off walkers after passing Trupp Park and finishing at Colfax Ave.

NOTE: Entrants on foot may exit parade route and enter Trupp Park in order for vehicles to exit the route expediently. Community Center Parking Lot is also available for unloading. Any parade participant displaying highly obscene and/or offensive material will not be allowed to participate in the parade.

ANIMAL PARTICIPATION

Parade entries that include walking animals (dogs, horses, etc.) will be required to designate an Animal Waste collector/cleaner. Please bring your own waste bags and anything else needed to clean up after the animals in your group. Animal waste should be cleaned up immediately during the parade procession.
