2. Bennett Gives Back Grant Recommendations

Danette Ruvalcaba, Town Accountant, reviewed the Bennett Gives Back Grant (BGB Grant), which may provide a grant up to 90% of the costs of a qualifying event, project, program or activity in an amount up to \$10,000 per organization per year from the Town's general fund. The purpose of the program is for eligible organizations and special districts to obtain additional resources to help supplement services or resources provided to the residents of Bennett. Awarded funds will be disbursed to applicant based on Board discretion and project limits.
