All New Residential Homes Must Submit:

- 1. Building Permit Application
 - Completely filled out through online application system
 - ALL contractors (including sub-contractors) must have a Town of Bennett Contractor License
- 2. Soil Report (1 Electronic Copy)
- 3. Site Plan (1 Electronic Copy)
 - Indicate property lines
 - Show dimensions between all structures and property lines as well as between the main structure and all other structures on lot
 - Provide a North arrow and scale including all directions
 - Show the utility routing plan
 - Include the property address
 - Include lot dimensions
 - Include legal description of the property
- 4. Grading/Erosion Control Plan (1 Electronic Copy)
- 5. Foundation Plans (1Electronic Copy)
- 6. Architectural Plans (1 Electronic Copy)
 - Floor plans (basements, crawl space, first floor, second floor).
 - Roof plans (all elevations), include roof ventilation calculations (number of vents and size), show location of the required roof vents on the roof layouts for each elevation.
 - Elevation plans and sections of the structures showing insulation R values and information for walls and roof/ceiling.
 - Details of fire ratings of exterior walls and shaft walls, penetration details, flashing, stair details, and window wells drainage.
 - Electrical plans.
 - Mechanical plans showing location of furnace, duct layouts, sizes of ducts, locations and all the fittings, and CFM for each register.
 - Truss layouts and details for each elevation stamped by the registered design engineer.
- 7. Completed Application from Bennett Watkins Fire Rescue
 - Receipt of fees paid included
- 8. Energy Code Compliance
 - Completed ResCheck specific to the home proposed or Energy Compliance Report from an energy rating company
 - Any plans that propose to prescriptively meet the IECC must submit sufficient documentation in their construction drawings to show complete compliance with the IECC prescriptive method

- 9. Verify Zoning Compliance
- 10. Provide Legal Description of the Property
 - Parcel number
 - Lot, block and subdivision
