

As the very first incorporated area east of Aurora, the Town of Bennett is uniquely positioned to capture the next wave of growth within the Denver Metropolitan area. Today, Bennett is leading the way for development on the eastern I-70 corridor.

BENNETT COMMUTE

Our geographical location east of the Denver Metropolitan Area is unique to potential developers. We are just 25 miles from the eastern edge of Aurora, 20 miles east of Denver International Airport and only 10 miles from Front Range Airport, a future potential Spaceport. Bennett is a 5.4 square mile town located in Adams and Arapahoe Counties; both counties are currently ranked in the top four for growth within the State.
